



## How to Get Mandela Barnes on the Ballot

Thank you SO much for helping us gather signatures to get Mandela Barnes on the ballot for Governor of Wisconsin. This is yet another great opportunity to show how much grassroots support we have across Wisconsin! This is obviously a critical component of our campaign, so we ask that you please review these instructions!

### Who Can Circulate/Collect and Sign Nomination Signatures?

- Petition circulators and signers must be “qualified electors” which means **they must be eligible Wisconsin voters, they do not need to be registered, just eligible to register to vote.** Generally that is anyone 18+ who has resided in Wisconsin for at least 28 days and has not lost their right to vote.
- **Circulators and signers can only do so for one democratic candidate for Governor.** They can sign and circulate nomination papers for other races such as Lieutenant Governor or State Senate, but not for any other Democratic candidate for Governor.

### What's my job?

- **As a circulator, you must personally witness each signature**, so papers cannot be left unattended.
- **After you have witnessed signatures, you will sign and date the bottom of the nomination papers.** You can not sign and date the bottom until you are not going to collect anymore signatures on that sheet (so either when the sheet is full or if you are done with it, please note that every sheet does not need to be full of signatures!). **If there are any signatures dated after when you sign the bottom, none of the signatures will be valid and counted.**
- You will engage your friends, family, neighbors, and community to ask them to sign nomination papers. **You will make sure all of their information is legible and filled out, the phone number and email address are not required.**

You should collect signatures at local events nearby, or even by going door to door. If you're on private property you must ask the owner for permission to collect signatures. **Please send complete forms to P.O. Box 90541 Milwaukee, WI 53209 by May 22** so we have the necessary time needed to submit the petitions to the Wisconsin Election Commission. The earlier the better and the more the better!
